

How to Safely Dispose of Leftover Medications

Properly disposing of prescription and over-the-counter medication protects others -- adults, teens, children and pets -- from purposeful or accidental misuse.

There are multiple sites throughout Richland County for free, safe and confidential disposal of prescription medications. Many are located inside local pharmacies or near grocery stores, making them an easy and convenient stop while running errands.

Throwing medication in the trash is not recommended because it can still be used if found.

Flushing medication down the toilet is also not recommended because it is not environmentally-friendly and can contaminate the local water supply.
