Ohioans Are Smoking More During the Pandemic

Ohio has been bringing in more tobacco taxes than projected. Cigarette tax revenue was \$16.1 million above September projections and \$23.5 million above 1st quarter projections for the current state fiscal year.

New Jersey is one more example where substances are moving towards decriminalization. This trend could lead to further reductions in youth perceptions of harm, especially for marijuana, which has already been dropping.
