<u>Tips To Use Medicines Safely</u>

Follow instructions for <u>YOUR</u> prescription! Read medicine labels.

Use prescription medicines only for the medical condition it was prescribed for.

Use the right amount. Don't take larger doses.

Don't share medicines with anyone or take someone else's prescribed medication. <u>Tips To Store Medicines Safely</u> Keep medicines in a lock box with a key or combination.

Keep medicines stored high and out of reach of children.

Put medicines away after every use.

Do not leave medicines out in the open.

Always keep medicine in its original container.
